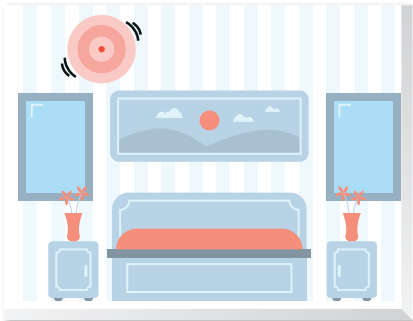


SAFEGUARD YOUR HOME

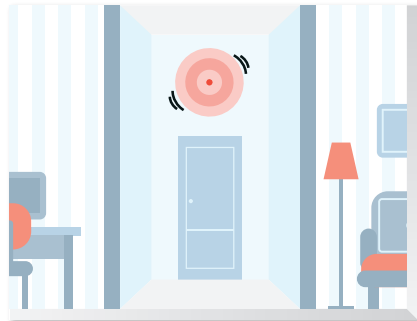

INSTALL SMOKE ALARMS:

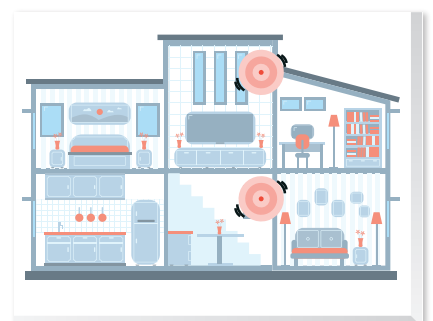
In Every Bedroom



Outside Each Sleeping Area



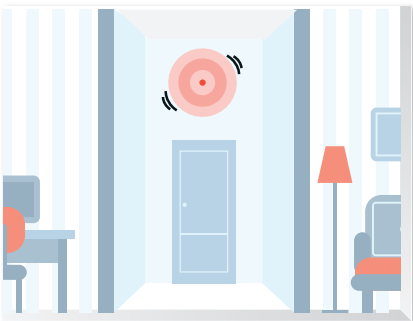
On Each Level of Your Home



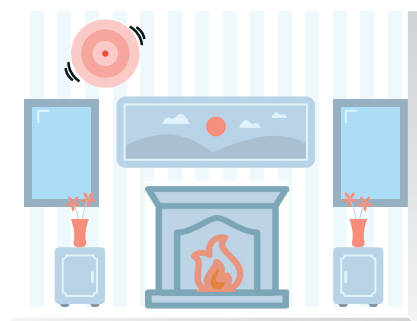
INSTALL CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS:
